## **Biography**

Ada María Isasi-Díaz was born on March 22, 1943 in La Habana, Cuba. She left Cuba in 1960 as a political refugee. She graduated with a Bachelor of Arts, with a major in European History from the College of New Rochelle, New York in 1971. In January 1967 she arrived in Lima, Peru to join the Ursuline sisters as a missionary, serving in the María Madre de Dios Parish as a Junior High School teacher until 1969. In May 1977 Isasi-Díaz earned an M.A. in Medieval History from State University of New York at Brockport and a permanent certificate as High School Teacher in New York in 1978. From Union Theological Seminary in New York she received a Master of Divinity in 1985, an M.Phil in 1989, and a Ph.D. in Christian Social Ethics in 1990. She received an honorary degree, Doctor of Laws, from Lynchburg College in Virginia.

From 1978 to 1982 Isasi-Díaz served as Regional Developer on the Office Ministerial Team of the Women's Ordination Conference in Rochester, New York. Isasi-Díaz began lecturing and writing in 1982. She was invited to lecture at Union Theological Seminary prior to beginning her doctoral program. Between 1987 and 1990 she served as a Director of Programs and Associate General Director of Church Women United in New York. Drew University in Madison, New Jersey appointed Isasi-Díaz was appointed as professor of Ethics and Theology at Drew University, Madison, New Jersey, in 1991, where she founded and was co-director of the Hispanic Institute of Theology in 1992.

Isasi-Díaz was an activist-theologian involved in the feminist theological movement. She worked on developing and elaborating a *Mujerista* theology, a theology from a U.S. Latina perspective. The Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project is one of the movements Isasi-Díaz was involved with and she was an active member of EATWOT, <a href="www.eatwot.org">www.eatwot.org</a>, whose records are also in the Burke Library Archives

On several occasions Isasi-Díaz has returned to teach at Seminario Ecuménico de Teología in Cuba. She continued to elaborate *Mujerista* theology in conversation with liberation and other women-centered theologies. Ada Maria Isasi-Diaz died in New York from cancer on May 13<sup>th</sup> 2012.

### **Collection Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of lectures, correspondence, working papers, publications, sermons, liturgies, professional awards and other related materials from the files of Ada María Isasi-Díaz. The materials in this collection span much of her professional career as an activist and theologian. The bulk of the collection consists of correspondence and publications from her work with women's organizations, manuscripts of lectures and articles, syllabi and teaching notes and conference materials. Also included are personal correspondence, audio- and videotapes, and clippings from magazines and newspapers.

The collection is divided into nine series, with one subseries:

## • <u>Series 1: Women's Ordination Conference / Rochester Regional Task Force, 1975 – 1989 (6 Boxes, 3.0 linear ft.)</u>

This series contain notes, correspondence, committee minutes, resource articles, proposals and reports relating to Isasi-Díaz's work as a member of the Women's Ordination Conference and the Rochester Regional Task Force. It also contains some reports prepared for the organization Las Hermanas. Arrangement is alphabetical by organization (Hermanas, RRTF, WOC) and type (contracts, correspondence, minutes, newsletter, programs, proposals, reports), and then chronological. Undated materials appear last in the chronological order, and some materials are in Spanish.

#### • Series 2: Lectures and Conferences, 1976 – 2009 (6 Boxes, 3.0 linear ft.)

Series 2 contains correspondence, drafts, outlines, programs, newspaper and magazine clippings pertaining to lectures and presentations by Isasi-Díaz. This series also contains Isasi-Díaz's homilies/sermons and chapel/church bulletins. Arrangement is chronological. Materials with no dates are arranged after the last chronologically dated file and then by alphabetical where titled. Some materials are in Spanish, Korean, Italian and German.

- Series 3: Publications, 1966 2009 (4 Boxes, 2.0 linear ft.)
  - Series 3 contains consent forms and correspondence pertaining to Isasi-Díaz's publications, article reprints and journals, and reviews of her books. There are also unpublished articles and Bible studies in this series. Some materials are in Spanish, Dutch and German. Arrangement is by type: (articles/publications, Bible studies, book reviews) and chronological, with undated materials appearing last in their topological order. Following these broader categories, titled publications are filed alphabetically.
- Series 4: Videotapes and Transparencies, 1979 2008 (2 Boxes, 0.75 linear ft.)
  Series 4 contains sixteen videotapes (one Betamax), recordings of Isasi-Díaz interviews, lectures or presentations. The series also includes fourteen color transparencies relating to research on her first book.
- Series 5: Audiotapes, 1976 2007 (1 Box, 0.5 linear ft.)

Series 5 contains audio recordings of conference/event lectures or presentations by Isasi-Díaz. In some cases, there are co-participants and in two instances: "Installation of Dr. James Forbes, Jr.", "Imagination and Inner Self", recordings are not primarily of Isasi-Diaz. There are also computer diskettes relating to her dissertation, a DVD and a recording tape reel. Some material may be in Spanish.

• Series 6: Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project, 2000 – 2007 (1 Box, 0.25 linear ft.) [RESTRICTED UNTIL JANUARY 1, 2032]

Series 6 contains reports, writings and correspondence related to the Sister Fund: Theological Renaissance Project. Also included are some papers regarding a Women Centered Theology group, which overlapped in membership with the Theological Renaissance Project.

• Series 7: Professional Activities: Teaching, Travel, Research and Awards, 1968 – 2009 (3 Boxes, 1.5 linear ft.)

Series 7 contains material regarding professional activities such as syllabi and course evaluations, teaching notes and resource files, overseas student trips, and academic awards. The bulk of the material relates to Isasi-Diaz's Drew University tenure, with additional material from engagements at other universities or academic programs. This series also contains photographs in color or black and white used for marketing/publicity purposes and faculty identification cards. Arrangement is chronological.

• Series 7A: Student Papers, 1988 – 2009 (1 Box, 0.25 linear ft.) [FERPA RESTRICTIONS]

Series 7A contains papers, master's thesis proposals, and completed theses written by students of Isasi-Diaz or of her colleagues. Some papers contain notations, comments or

grading, and some are in Spanish. Each paper is individually filed, except for one folder containing multiple papers by students in the Drew Hispanic D.Min Program. Arrangement is chronological.

## • <u>Series 8: Correspondence: Professional and Personal, 1980 – 2009 (1 Box, 0.5 linear ft.)</u>

Series 8 contains professional and personal correspondence in the form of letters, notes, greeting cards, email and fax communications. This series also contains a color group photo. Arrangement is chronological.

#### • Series 9: Oversized (1 Oversized Horizontal Box, 2.5 linear ft.)

Series 9 is an oversized box containing a variety of materials properly belonging to other series but unable to fit in a regular-sized series box. The bulk of the material is conference related posters and newspapers. Also included is a plaque of the *Mujerista Theology* book cover. Arrangement is by first occurrence in the original series order (Series # Box # f #).

#### **Processing**

When the Burke Library acquired Isasi-Díaz's papers, an attempt was made to maintain the original order she imposed throughout the course of her career. However, some rationalization was introduced for ease of access, research usage and physical preservation. Staples, rubber bands, and metal clips were removed and replaced with plastic clips. Post-it notes and some newspaper clippings were photocopied on acid free paper. All materials were placed in acid-free folders and boxes.

Folded materials were flattened and large items transferred from their original positions into oversized boxes. While oversized items are not listed in their original position in the Contents List, a note in the original folder states a reference to its folder placement in oversized Series 9. Likewise, a note exists in the Series 9 folder referring to the original series folder and contents therein relating to the item.
