Abstract: In 1900 Dr. W. W. White founded the Bible Teachers' College, renamed

Bible Teachers' Training School. From 1921 the School was renamed Biblical Seminary New York. In 1966 BSNY was renamed New York Theological Seminary. The collection covers the history of the seminary, and includes Columbiona on Lake George, writings and periodicals.

### **Organizational History**

After an initial meeting on October 29th 1900 <u>Wilbert Webster White</u> opened the **Bible Teachers' College** in Montclair, New Jersey on January 8<sup>th</sup> 1901 with 32 students and White as the only teacher. Unlike other similar institutions, the College was founded by White with the Bible as the central focus of the curriculum. From this beginning New York Theological Seminary (NYTS) developed, although the seminary's name has changed several times over the years.

The Bible Teachers' College was planned by White to be neither a Bible Institute nor a Theological Seminary. However, because it did not meet the New York State's criteria as a college, it was renamed the **Bible Teachers' Training School** when it moved to New York in 1902. In those early days most students, a large proportion being women, were aiming to undertake the career of Bible teacher, missionary or YMCA worker rather than as minister.

This seminary, from its early years, was open to both men and women from different denominations and cultural traditions. Some courses were held in Italian, when many Italian immigrants were arriving in New York, and later courses using Korean and other languages were provided according to need. Early seminary photographs show a proportion of women as both students and teachers, with some international students dressed in their national costumes.

The institution's name was changed to **Biblical Seminary of New York** when it moved to four neighborhood houses in downtown New York in 1921.



In 1927 a new building was opened for BSNY on East 49<sup>th</sup> street, with 2 of its nine floors operating as neighborhood houses.

As a special project in 1925 Biblical Seminary, with assistance from a donor, purchased property on Silver Bay, Lake George, in upper New York State. The property became known as **Columbiona on the Lake**. President White named this from a combination of the name of Saint Columba and the Scottish Island of Iona. Starting in the summer of 1925 White initiated the first of the multiple summer conferences at this peaceful site. An average of fifteen to twenty men pastors, seminary presidents and professors, as well as administrative staff from denominational or ecumenical boards attended each conference by invitation from W. W. White. Columbiona conferences continued for 6 years, with President W. W. White as their charismatic leader.

1965/6 saw the renaming of Biblical Seminary New York as **New York Theological Seminary.** In 1969 George W. "Bill" Webber was hired as Chief Development Officer, then as President. NYTS was relocated within New York in the 1970s with a redesign of its mission responding to the needs of urban churches and pastors. The Seminary's former properties in New York on 49<sup>th</sup> Street were sold in 1982. Since 2002 NYTS is located at the Interchurch Center in Morningside Heights, New York, with classes held in nearby Riverside Church..

#### **Collection Scope and Content Note**

This collection consists mainly of the earlier twentieth century records of the Biblical Seminary of New York, including some content from its formerly named Bible Teacher's Training School. Included in this finding aid is a small subseries concerning Columbiona on Lake George.

#### • Series 1: Biblical Seminary New York Records, 1881 - 1973

The Records in this collection provide, in three subseries, historic information on the earlier history and development of the institution which became the current New York Theological Seminary. The first large subseries provides the legal papers, teaching and promotional activities of Biblical Seminary while the second subseries concentrates on the period of the second world war as seen through the remaining records of the Seminary Comptroller's office. The final subseries contains information concerning Dr. White's project of the Columbiona on Lake George conference and retreat facility.

# • Subseries 1A:Biblical Seminary New York, 1881 - 1973 (20 Boxes, 10 linear ft.)

The Biblical Seminary New York (BSNY) contains a range of records covering the founding, management and activities within the seminary. Groups of papers cover constitutions, legal issues and committee meetings, curriculum development and speeches, reports and writings, historical writings and subject files. A section of BSNY and Faculty publications completes the subseries.

# • Subseries 1B: Comptrollers' Office Records, 1914, 1932-1949 (6 Boxes, 3 linear ft.)

This administrative subseries includes regular correspondence concerning staff and building issues, calendars of Seminary events, student accounts and financial matters. The bulk of the material covers the period of 1940-1945, where administrative items relating to wartime regulations can be found. Within this group can be found the BSNY Absolute Charter, which enabled the Seminary for the first time to award degrees through an agreement with New York University. In addition can be seen a small group of photographs, postcards and incomplete photo albums. Much of this subseries consists of acidic and crumbling paper which is extremely FRAGILE and care in handling is requested.

# • Subseries 1C: Columbiona on Lake George Records, 1915-1941 (2 Boxes and 1 Half Box, 1.25 linear ft.)

This series reveals the work carried out in the relatively short lived outpost of BSNY at Columbiona on Lake George, which was used as a summer conference center. Documents reveal the founding of the Columbiona conferences with letters of appreciation and other materials including a small collection of President Whites' conference program notes and a group of photographs and postcards. Three original items in this group were not received by the Burke archives: Speech-Armageddon, 1939-1940, Sorry for God Series, 1940 and Was Abraham a Christian?

### **Processing**

The records were processed into acid free boxes and folders. Fragile acidic pages may be found within the folders and should be handled with care.
